

Android Devices


You will need:

- The Overdrive Media Console app for Android, available from Google Play (if your device doesn't support Google Play, but is an android device, you can download the Android app directly from Overdrive by going to www.overdrive.com/software/omc)
- A library card and pin number
- An Adobe ID
- An email address

Go to the library's website, www.nelsoncopublib.org, on your device. On the right side of the screen, click on 'Download'.



This takes you to the Kentucky Libraries Unbound Digital Media Catalog. This is where you can search for ebooks, audiobooks, video, and music to download from the library.



Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on “software” on the left side.

If your device doesn't support Google Play, you can download OverDrive Media Console for Android from OverDrive.

Follow the prompts to install Overdrive Media Console on your device. You may have to change a setting to allow installation of apps on your device.

Once you have OMC installed on your device, it will appear in your apps screen and possibly on your home screen with this icon:



If Overdrive does not open automatically, open it from your home screen and you'll see something similar to the picture below. Uncheck "show at start-up".



You may be prompted to authorize the app with an Adobe ID. If you are not prompted, locate and tap the “menu” button on the screen. Then tap “App settings”, where you will be prompted to authorize the App with and Adobe ID.



If you do not have an Adobe ID, click the link to create one.




